Policy Statement: The Low Flow Toilet Replacement Policy is intended to recognize Town of High River water utility customers who are committed to reducing water consumption by incorporating new Low Flow Toilets in their homes and/or business.

Purpose of Policy: To maintain and improve water conservation through implementation of a low flow toilet replacement program for Water Utility Customers within the Town of High River.

Policy Benefits: The Town of High River offers conditional rebates on qualifying toilets as an incentive for water conservation. Water utility customers can benefit from the low flow or dual flush toilets in a reduction of water consumption and therefore a reduction in their water utility bill. The Town of High River will benefit from a reduction in water usage, conservation of well water, and a reduction in power usage used to treat the water.

Definitions:

Low Flow: A toilet that uses 6 L of water or less.

Dual Flush: A low flow toilet utilizing two different flush sizes. A whole flush (6 litres per flush) and a short flush (3 litres per flush). The user has the option to choose the amount of water needed to flush the waste.
