

THE TOWN OF HIGH RIVER

BY-LAW NO. 3470/83

A By-Law of the Town of High River in the Province of Alberta to limit the speed of trains at railway crossings within the Town Limits.

WHEREAS

Pursuant to Section 165(1)(d) of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 1980 cM-26, a council may pass a by-law to provide and regulate the speed of cars on any and every part of the railroad.

AND WHEREAS

The Council of the Town of High River wishes to limit the speed of trains at railway crossings within the Town Limits.

NOW THEREFORE

Council of the Town of High River enacts as follows:

1. That there be a maximum speed of entry to all railway crossings within the Town Limits; these crossings are:
  - (a) Crossing of 1st Avenue South known as Mileage 38.45 MacLeod Subdivision;
  - (b) Crossing of 3rd Avenue known as Mileage 38.57 MacLeod Subdivision;
  - (c) Crossing of 7th Avenue known as Mileage 38.82 Macleod Subdivision; and
  - (d) Crossing of 12th Avenue known as Mileage 39.14 MacLeod Subdivision
2. The maximum speed to enter these crossings or any additional future crossings shall be no greater than 10 miles per hour (16.093 kilometres per hour).

This By-Law comes into effect on the day of the Final Reading thereof.
